

MINUTES OF THE TMACOG * AIR QUALITY COMMITTEE *

The meeting was held on February 16, 2011 at 8:00 a.m. in the TMACOG Boardroom, 300 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Toledo OH 43604.

- 1. Welcome and Introductions** — Tim Brown welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made.
- 2. Approval of Agenda** — The agenda was approved on a motion by Bill Herr, seconded by Don Lieder.
- 3. Approval of November 17, 2010 Minutes** — The minutes were approved on a motion by Bill Herr, seconded by Mark Budge.
- 4. Criteria Pollutant Discussion - Lead** – Mark Budge presented information on lead. He noted that the lead standard is $.15 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ of lead using the 3-month average within a 3 year period. Currently there is a monitor in Fulton County but none in Lucas or Wood Counties. Additional monitors may be installed in the future with one possibly located in Lucas County. Lead can have a variety of effects on the body including damage to the nervous system, damage to red blood cells, and weakening the immune system in children and increase blood pressure, cardiovascular disease and decreased kidney function in adults.
- 5. Air Quality Advocacy Report** – Don Scherer was unable to attend the meeting.
- 6. Air Quality News and Administrative Items** – Dave Gedeon reported that the ozone standard has been delayed yet again. In a notice filed on December 8, 2010, the US EPA states that they now intend to issue the new ozone standard by July 29, 2011. Dave also discussed the development of a legislative agenda for air quality. This was an item included in the FY 2011 Annual Work Program. It was determined that there is currently nothing of substance that the committee wish to comment on and thus no legislative agenda is needed at this time. Dave presented a draft of the FY 2012 Annual Work program for the committees review. The committee reviewed the document and approved it as written.
- 7. Share a Ride Road Signs/Ozone Action Season** – Greg Gettum reported that ODOT has begun to install the road signs. Presently, seven signs are in place. The signs are scheduled to be up by the end of March, weather permitting. The Ozone Action Season marketing campaign will kickoff soon and will include billboards, sponsorship of traffic spots of local radio stations, and a television campaign on channel 11.
