

MINUTES OF THE TMACOG * AIR QUALITY COMMITTEE *

The meeting was held on November 17, 2010 at 8:00 a.m. in the TMACOG Boardroom, 300 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Toledo OH 43604.

- 1. Welcome and Introductions** — Tim Brown welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made.
- 2. Approval of Agenda** — The agenda was approved on a motion by Bill Herr, seconded by Mark Budge.
- 3. Approval of July 21, 2010 Minutes** — The minutes were approved on a motion by Mark Budge, seconded by Bill Herr.
- 4. Lead Designations for Ohio** – David Gedeon reported that the EPA has designed Delta, OH as a nonattainment area for lead. Monitoring data shows a violation of the 2008 lead NAAQS based on 2006-2008 and 2007-2009 air quality data. There are a couple facilities in Delta that are thought to be the cause of the violation. Following some general discussion on lead, Mark Budge offered to provide additional information on the pollutant at the next meeting.
- 5. Air Quality Advocacy Report** – Don Scherer was unable to attend the meeting.
- 6. Share a Ride Road Signs** – Greg Gettum reported that Safeway Barricades has produced the new Share A Ride highway signs and they will be in place by March. Greg noted that there are still some very old Share A Ride Signs up in the City of Toledo that have the old 241-1919 phone number on it that need to be taken down but there is no inventory of locations. He asked that he be contacted if anyone sees the old signs.
- 7. Climate Change Legislation Update** – David Gedeon stated that all of the climate change legislation following the elections. Each piece of legislations appears to be stalled and there has been little discussion of them moving forward. Ken Fallows said that cap and trade legislation is not dead but likely on hold for at least a couple years.
- 8. Other Business** – Mark Budge said that EPA is still pushing the new permitting process for early January.
- 9. Adjourn** – There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned.
