

FY 2020 Surface Transportation Block Grant Program Scoring and Ranking - STAFF REPORT

TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

The proposed scoring and ranking of the FY 2020 solicitation of Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP) funding is now presented on the following spreadsheet to the Board of Trustees for consideration. TMACOG seeks approval to allocate approximately \$14,000,000 of STBGP funding through state fiscal year 2025 to project applications received in this round.

TMACOG received 35 applications from nine entities requesting \$61,143,925 of STBGP funding. The projects received were reviewed, scored, and ranked by a subcommittee of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Committee. The scoring and ranking presented in this resolution has been approved by the TIP Committee and the Transportation Council.
