

FY 2020 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Scoring and Ranking - STAFF REPORT

TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

The proposed scoring and ranking of the FY 2020 solicitation of Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding is now presented on the following spreadsheet for consideration. TMACOG seeks approval to allocate approximately \$6,800,000 of CMAQ funding through state fiscal year 2025 to projects applications received in this round.

In 2013, ODOT consolidated CMAQ funding into a statewide pool of funds managed by the eight of the largest MPOs in Ohio (Cleveland, Columbus, Cincinnati, Toledo, Dayton, Akron, Canton, and Youngstown). The statewide pool is managed by representatives from each of the MPOs through the Ohio Statewide Urban CMAQ Committee (OSUCC). Projects are solicited and scored locally by each MPO using a standardized application and scoring methodology established by OSUCC. Following scoring and ranking and approval by MPO boards, the project recommendations are brought back to OSUCC for vetting and final awards are approved by the Ohio Association of Regional Councils (OARC) Executive Directors, comprised of the executive directors/presidents from each MPO.

TMACOG received thirteen applications from seven entities requesting \$23,107,399 of CMAQ funding. The projects received were reviewed, scored, and ranked by a subcommittee of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Committee. The scoring and ranking presented in this resolution has been approved by the TIP Committee, the Transportation Council, and the TMACOG Executive Committee.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization by the Governor of Ohio in cooperation with local elected officials and is authorized to carry out the continuing, comprehensive, and coordinated transportation planning process for the Toledo area; and

WHEREAS, the addition of funds in this resolution was approved by Transportation Improvement Committee on August 26, 2019, by the Transportation Council on September 4, 2019, and by the TMACOG Executive Committee on September 18, 2019.
