At the annual TMACOG General Assembly held January 25, Carol Contrada, Lucas County Commissioner, was elected as chair of TMACOG. Nelson Evans, mayor of Perrysburg, was elected Vice chair; and Don Nalley, council member, City of Fremont joined TMACOG leadership as second vice chair. The panel was elected for a one-year term.

About 120 TMACOG members attended the General Assembly held at the Grand Lobby of the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Plaza.
