

## 2007-2035 Transportation Plan Task Force

The Task Force wishes to get input from the four main sectors of the community (business/industry, neighborhoods, government, and institutions) throughout the Plan development process. The Task Force will seek their comments on specific issues. The first “sector feedback loop” is slated for May 2005.

### **Sector Feedback Loop #1: Spring 2005**

#### **Content:**

- 1 Announce 2035 Plan process
- 2 Ask for input on Vision Statement / Goals
- 3 Ask for help in disseminating Plan information to the members of their sector
- 4 Ask them to review and comment on land use and development assumptions needed to run the traffic forecasting model:
  - current and draft 2035 population projections; current and 2035 employment

#### **Methods:**

- 1 Identify major sectors from which input is desired throughout Plan process
- 2 Set strategies appropriate for each sector
  - Example, hold meetings for input from Wood County and Lucas County business/economic development sectors (determine whether NORED, the regional economic development association, and Chambers of Commerce would invite members)
