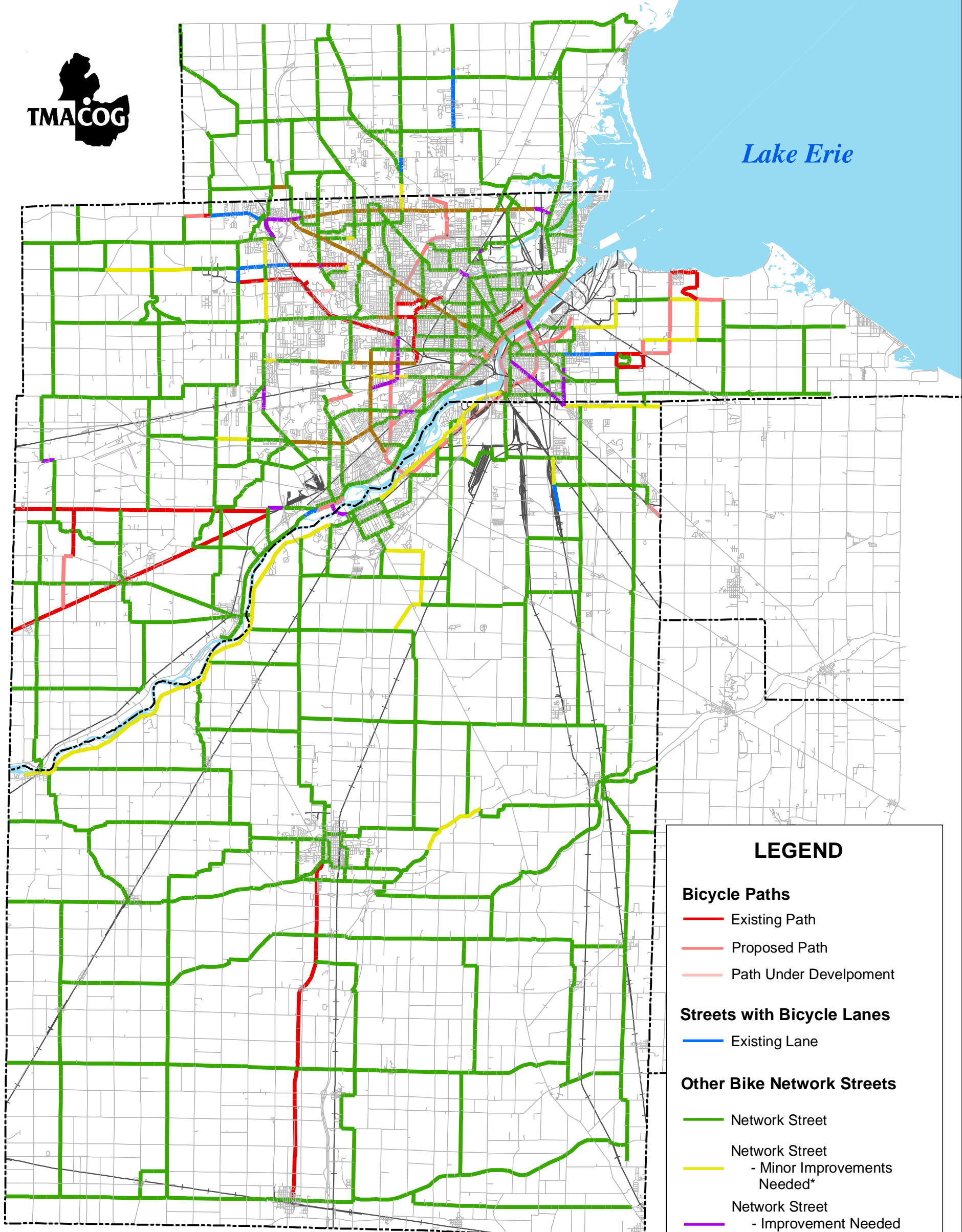


# 2025 Regional Transportation Plan - Update 2004 Bicycle Network

\* Minor improvements generally mean paved berms (preferred) or widened outside lanes (14 feet) to increase the safety and security of the cyclists.

\*\* Improvements to reduce hazards include adding bike lanes or paved berms on streets and bridges that are narrow and/or heavily traveled, plus eliminating hazards to cyclists caused by angled rail tracks, sudden changes in road width, merging traffic, dangerous intersections, etc.

\*\*\* Types of facilities include bike paths, bike lanes, paved berms and widened (14 feet) outside travel lanes.
