Proposed Regional Signed Bicycle Route Network

To help cyclists travel safely, a project is underway to sign 22 regional bike routes.

- Bike Route 20 is signed (thanks to the Lucas County Engineer, Oregon, Toledo, and Ottawa Hills). Bike Route 5 is under design. The other routes are proposed. We would like your comments on all of them.
- To provide comments, you can use the attached form if you wish (it follows the route descriptions below).
- Signs are **white rectangles with a green oval**, a bike symbol and the route number.
- The routes mostly follow ordinary streets. They also may follow bike paths and streets with specially-marked bike lanes.
- Signed bicycle routes are for navigating: you can follow them to get somewhere on your bike, just like you follow a state route in your car.
- The routes are based on our TMACOG regional 25-year transportation plan.
- Cyclists are vehicles under state law. When riding on any street, you must follow the rules of the road. That includes riding with (not against) traffic.

NORTH - SOUTH BICYCLE ROUTES

(see Map)

Route 1

In Lucas County, Ohio: Lathrop Rd. (from Lenawee County Line) to Old State Line Rd., Scott Rd., Airport Hwy., Girdham Rd., Reed Rd., Manore Rd., Ludwig Rd., Grand Rapids Rd./SR-578 (Bridge St.).

Continues in Wood County, Ohio: SR 578/Bridge St., River Rd./ SR 65, Sycamore Rd., Long-Judson Rd., Beaver Creek Rd., *Poe Rd., *Milton Rd., *Kiel Rd./Main St., *Sand Ridge Rd., Custar Rd. south to Hancock-Wood County Rd.

*Optional Alternate Route: From Poe Rd., take Custar Rd. south to Sand Ridge Rd.

Route 3

In Wood County, Ohio: SR 582 (from SR 65), Tontogany Creek Rd., Kellogg Rd., Tontogany Rd., Long-Judson Rd., Green Rd., Poe Rd., Liberty Hi Rd., Euler Rd., Range Line Rd. south to *Deshler Rd./SR-18

*Possible Extension: Range Line Rd. from Deshler Rd. south to Hancock County Line

Route 5 - PLANNED FOR SIGNING IN 2003

In Monroe County, Michigan: Sylvania-Petersburg Rd. (from Goetz/Rauch Rd.), Sterns Rd., Sylvania-Petersburg Rd. (turns into Summit St.)

Continues in Lucas County, Ohio: (Enter City of Sylvania) Summit St., Maplewood Ave., Silica Rd., Convent Blvd., Silica Rd., Brint Rd., King Rd., Angola Rd., Albon Rd., Monclova Rd., Waterville-Monclova Rd., Dutch Rd., Waterville-Monclova Rd., SR 64 (to Village of Waterville), Farnsworth Rd., River Rd., SR 64/Mechanic St. (bridge)

Continues in Wood County, Ohio: SR 64, SR-65, Reitz Rd., Hull Prairie Rd., Bishop Rd., Brim Rd. (enter City of Bowling Green), Newton Rd., Fairview Ave., Conneaut Ave., Maple St., Sand Ridge Rd., Slippery Elm Trail south to Eagleville Rd. (in North Baltimore)

Route 7

In Monroe County, Michigan: Douglas Rd. (from Samaria Rd.) into Lucas County/City of Toledo

Continues in Lucas County, Ohio: Douglas Rd., Arletta St., Tremainsville Rd., Upton Ave., South Cove Bike Path, Parkside Bike Path south to Hill Ave.

Route 9

In Wood County, Ohio: (from Veterans Memorial Park) Jennings St., Eagle Point Rd., Colony Rd., Lime City Rd., Five Point Rd., Dunbridge Rd., Reitz Rd., Carter Rd., Dowling Rd., Carter Rd. south to SR 105

Route 11

In Wood County, Ohio: In Pemberville (from SR 105) - Bierley Ave., North River Rd., Caskie Rd., Linwood Rd., Emerson Rd., Portage Rd., Bloomdale Rd., Greensburg Pike, Reynolds Rd., Jerry City Rd., Bloomdale Rd. south to Eagleville Rd.*

*Possible Extension: Continue south on Bloomdale Rd. (becomes Main St. in Village of Bloomdale) to Hancock County Line.

Route 13

In Wood County, Ohio: Lemoyne Rd. (from Curtice Rd.), Sugar Ridge Rd., Wegman Rd. (into Village of Pemberville), College Ave., Bierley Ave., South St., Eisenour Rd. east to Bradner Rd.

Route 15

In Wood County, Ohio: Bradner Rd. (from Curtice Rd.), Birch Rd. south to Eagleville Rd.

Route 17

In Monroe County, Michigan: Lewis Ave. (from Rauch Rd.), Dean Rd., Crabb Rd., Lavoy Rd., Dixie Hwy./MI-125 south to Benore Rd.

Continues in Lucas County, Ohio: Benore Rd., Stickney Ave., Sherman St., Mulberry St., Bancroft St. west to Cherry St.

EAST -WEST BICYCLE ROUTES

(see Map)

Route 2

In Wood County, Ohio: Reigle Rd. (from Henry County Line), becomes Deshler Rd./SR 18. At Village of North Baltimore bear left onto Eagleville Rd. which becomes Broadway and then Eagleville Rd. again. Bushey Rd., Eagleville Rd., Fast Rd., Stearns Rd east to US 23/Seneca County Line

Route 4

In Wood County, Ohio: Eagleville Rd. (from Fast Rd.), east to US 23/Seneca County Line

Route 6

In Wood County, Ohio: Cygnet Rd. (from Henry County Line) east to Seneca County Line

Route 8

In Wood County, Ohio: Mermill Rd. (from Henry County Line), Steen Rd., Greensburg Pike, Steen Rd., Portage Rd./Main St., Wayne Rd., Douglas Rd., Timmons Rd./Glenwood Ave., Caldwell Rd./Chestnut Ridge east to Sandusky County Line.

Route 10

In Wood County, Ohio: Poe Rd., (from Henry County Line), Liberty Hi Rd., Gorrill Rd./Conneaut Ave., Fairview Ave., Merry Ave., Enterprise St., Frazee Ave., North College Dr., Merry Ave., Mercer Rd., Poe Rd., SR 105/Scotch Ridge Rd., Silverwood Rd., Alexander Rd. east to North River Rd. (Village of Pemberville)

Route 12

In Wood County, Ohio: SR 65/River Rd. (from Henry County Line), W. Boundary St., Second St., E. Boundary St., SR 65/River Rd./Dixie Hwy. east to Lucas County Line.

In Lucas County, Ohio: SR 65/Miami St., Oakdale Ave., Oak St., Front St. north to Main St.

Route 14

In Lucas County, Ohio: River Rd. (from US 24), which becomes Broadway St. then River Rd., then Broadway again, then Summit St. north to the Ottawa River Bridge in Point Place

In Monroe County, Michigan: Summit St. (from Ottawa River) north to Sterns Rd.

Route 16

In Lucas County, Ohio: Wabash Cannonball Trail South Fork (from Fulton County Line), Jerome Rd., proposed Bike/Ped. Bridge over US 24, proposed Fallen Timbers Trail (Metroparks), *River Rd. (Maumee) east to Broadway/Bike Rt. 14

*Possible Alternate: Through Side Cut MetroPark on the Towpath Trail to get to the Maumee-Perrysburg Bridge; then across Bridge to future Perrysburg route

Route 18

In Lucas County, Ohio: (In Oak Openings Preserve Metropark) Wabash Cannonball Trail North Fork (from Fulton County Line), Jerome Rd., Monclova Rd., Old Trail/Wayne St., Ford St. south to Broadway St. (Bike Route 14)

Route 20 – EXISTING SIGNED ROUTE

In Lucas County, Ohio: Bancroft St. (from Fulton County Line), Cherry St., Martin Luther King Bridge (over Maumee River), Main St., Front St., Morrison Dr., Ravine Pkwy., Seaman St., Whittlesey Ave., Starr Ave. bike lanes, *Stadium Rd., *Bayshore Rd. bike path east to Maumee Bay State Park

*Alternate Route 20A: (from Stadium Rd.) Corduroy Rd. east almost to Lake Erie

Route 22

In Monroe County, Michigan: *Head O Lake Rd. (from Old US 223), Consear Rd., Summerfield Rd., Erie Rd., Dixie Hwy., Luna Pier Rd. east to Luna Pier

*Alternate Route: Beck Rd., (from Old US 223), Head O Lake Rd. north to Consear Rd.
