

**FY 2012-2015 TIP Amendment #3 - STAFF REPORT**

TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS  
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AGENDA  
DECEMBER 14, 2011

Proposed Amendment #3 to the recently enacted FY 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program was approved by Transportation Council on November 2, 2011 however has not been subsequently acted upon by the Executive Committee. Therefore TIP Amendment #3 is revised to include further projects and take the following actions:

**A RESOLUTION OF THE  
TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS  
MAKING AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE  
TO THE FY 2012-2015 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization by the Governor of Ohio in cooperation with local elected officials and is authorized to carry out the continuing, comprehensive, and coordinated transportation planning process for the Toledo area; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) was approved by the TMACOG Board of Trustees by Resolution Number 2011-09 on June 8, 2011; and Amendments #1 and #2 were previously approved; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to move the fiscal year of three projects, revise funding for two project, add eleven new projects to the TIP; and

WHEREAS, projects in this resolution were approved by the TIP Committee on October 24, 2011 and on November 28, 2011 and by the Transportation Council on December 7, 2011;
