

FY 2018-2021 TIP Amendment #13 - STAFF REPORT

Proposed Amendment #13 to the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program as approved by the Transportation Improvement Program Committee and approved by the Transportation Council is now presented to the Executive Committee for consideration.

1. Modifies three projects in the FY 2018-2021 TIP at the request of ODOT. The projects are:

a. City of Rossford – WOO SR 65/Lime City/Colony

b.

PID 90674 \$1,742,573 – Federal/Local – FY 2020 – CO

The amendment is increasing the construction estimate from \$1,105,650 to \$1,742,573, and the project is being moved from FY 2019 to FY 2020.

c. Wood County – WOO CR 107 1.73 Oregon Rd

PID 104428 \$222,000 – Federal/Local – FY 2019 – PE

\$55,555 – Federal/Local – FY 2020 – PE (DD)

\$55,555 – Federal/Local – FY 2020 – RW

The amendment is adding federal safety money to the Preliminary Engineering and Right-of-Way phases.

d. City of Toledo – LUC US 24 20.07

PID 100194 \$1,455,467 – Federal/Local – FY2019 – CO

The amendment is increasing the construction estimate from \$550,000 to \$1,455,467.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE

MAKING AMENDMENT NUMBER THIRTEEN
TO THE FY 2018-2021 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization by the Governor of Ohio in cooperation with local elected officials and is authorized to carry out the continuing, comprehensive, and coordinated transportation planning process for the Toledo area; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) was approved by the TMACOG Board of Trustees by Resolution Number 2017-09 on April 12, 2017; and amendments #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, #8, #9, #10, #11, and #12 were previously approved; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to modify three projects in the local TIP; and

WHEREAS, the project modifications in this resolution were approved by Transportation Improvement Committee on January 28, 2019, and were approved by the Transportation Council on February 6, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS:

Section 1

THAT the following projects be modified in the FY 2018-2021 TIP at the request of ODOT. The projects are:

Section 4


