

**FY 2016-2019 TIP Amendment #15 - STAFF REPORT**

TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS  
 BOARD OF TRUSTEE MEETING AGENDA

Proposed Amendment #15 to the FY 2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program is now presented to the Board of Trustees for consideration.

1. Modifies two City of Toledo projects at the request of the City of Toledo to the FY 2016-2019 TIP. The projects are:
  - a. City of Toledo – LUC SR 25 8.52 (AWT) Reconstruct  
 PID 95676    Current Funding    \$940,000 – STBGP – FY2015 – RW  
    Additional Funding    \$990,000 – STBGP – FY2017 – RW  
 Project modification is increasing the RW amount by \$990,000, bringing the total to \$1,930,000 in STBGP for RW. If in the future there is a shortfall, the City of Toledo will be asked to move a project back to cover the shortfall.
  - b. City of Toledo – LUC Bancroft St Reconstruct  
 PID 95686    Current Funding    \$7,480,800 – STBGP – FY2018 – CO  
    Revised Funding    \$8,280,800 – STBGP – FY2018 – CO  
 The modification adds \$800,000 to CO.

MAKING AMENDMENT NUMBER FOURTEEN  
TO THE FY 2016-2019 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization by the Governor of Ohio in cooperation with local elected officials and is authorized to carry out the continuing, comprehensive, and coordinated transportation planning process for the Toledo area; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) was approved by the TMACOG Board of Trustees by Resolution Number 2015-10 on June 17, 2015; and amendments #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, #8, #9, #10, #11, #12, #13, and #14 were previously approved; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to add one project and modify two projects to the local TIP; and

WHEREAS, the project addition and project modifications in this resolution were approved by the Transportation Improvement Committee on October 24, 2016 and by Transportation Council on December 7, 2016; and
