

FY 2018-2021 TIP Amendment #3 - STAFF REPORT

TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

Proposed Amendment #3 to the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program is now presented to the Executive Committee for consideration.

1. Modifies three projects in the FY 2018-2021 TIP at the request of the City of Toledo. These projects utilize TMACOG-managed funds. The projects are:
 - a. City of Toledo – Front St Resurfacing
PID 104422 Current Funding – \$2,752,160 – STBG – FY 2021 – CO
 Revised Funding - \$4,350,000 – STBG – FY 2019 – CO
Project sponsor will become the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority. Project scope will be increased to include roundabouts at Front St and Millard Ave and at Millard Ave and Tiffin St. Project STBG amount being increased by \$1,600,000.
 - b. City of Toledo – Bennett Rd Reconstruction
PID 98909 Current Funding - \$1,821,040 – STBG – FY 2020 – CO
 Revised Funding - \$1,821,040 – STBG – FY2022 – CO
The project is being moved from FY2020 to FY2022.
 - c. City of Toledo – Summit St Enhancement
PID 99000 Current Funding - \$610,364 – TA – FY2019 – CO
 Revised Funding - \$776,944 – TA – FY2020 – CO
The amendment is adding \$166,580 in TA and moving the project to FY2020.
2. Modify one project in the FY 2018-2021 TIP at the request of the Metroparks. This project does utilize TMACOG-managed funds. The project is:
 - a. Metroparks – Oak Openings Trail
PID 104274 Current Funding - \$158,252 – TA – FY 2018 – CO
 Revised Funding - \$158,252 – TA – FY2020 - CO
The modification is changing the project scope to the south of the current project. The Metroparks is using Clean Ohio money for the section that was originally applied for.

TO THE FY 2018-2021 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization by the Governor of Ohio in cooperation with local elected officials and is authorized to carry out the continuing, comprehensive, and coordinated transportation planning process for the Toledo area; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) was approved by the TMACOG Board of Trustees by Resolution Number 2017-09 on April 12, 2017; and amendments #1 and #2 were previously approved; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to modify four projects in the local TIP; and

WHEREAS, the project modifications in this resolution were approved by Transportation Improvement Committee on October 23, 2017, and were approved by the Transportation Council on November 1, 2017; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOLEDO METROPOLITAN AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS:
