#### 1. Convene meeting/introductions/approval of January Task Force Minutes

Ron Myers convened the meeting and the January meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Gary Stookey to accept the minutes and Ken Fallows seconded and the motion passed.

#### 2. 2045 On the Move 2020 Update

- a. **Plan Process Schedule Update** – Dana Doubler went over the updates to the Task Force Schedule since the January meeting. Updates included completion of the Survey, which is currently open for the people to take. The Transportation Plan itself is being updated, and the Public Meetings will begin next week.
- b. **Public Meeting Outline** – Dana Doubler encouraged the Task Force to sign up to attend a public meeting. Presentations are not required of the committee, instead Task Force members would simply answer questions and take comments from the public. She went over the maps which will be displayed at the public meetings, along with the handouts and presentation which will be shown. She asked if anyone had any suggestions for the handouts, to contact her.
- c. **Transportation Needs Breakout Session** – The committee was broken up into four groups, one for congestion, one for safety, one for freight movement, and one for personal mobility. The groups then discussed and brainstormed what the needs are for the region. The group for personal mobility emphasized the need for improved pedestrian, bicycle, public transit, and ADA facilities. The safety group emphasized education, funding, and enforcement. The freight group highlighted different freight connectors in need across the region. Lastly, the congestion group noted areas of congestion.

#### 3. Next Steps

At the next Task Force meeting, the committee will develop needs for infrastructure condition, system reliability, environmental sustainability, and project delivery. Dana

Doubler will present on the results from the Public Meetings, and lastly she will get stakeholder input from area businesses and governments.
