



Presentation Rules and Criteria

General Rules

We want to make sure that everyone gets the most out of the SWW Summit. To ensure a positive experience for all attendees, please adhere to the following rules (presenters who disregard these guidelines may be disqualified from awards judging):

- Please make sure you arrive prior to the beginning of the program. If you are delayed, we will ask that you wait for a break between speakers/presentations before your group enters the auditorium.
- Out of respect for your fellow presenters, you should plan to stay for all student presentations.
- Presentations must be made by students only- we ask that teachers remain in the audience and do not join their students on stage.
- Presentations should be no longer than 6-8 minutes. A moderator will be present and will ask groups to leave the stage in order to begin the next presentation.
- To remain within the time limit, we ask that a subset of students present for the group: no more than 7 students should be on stage at a time. We encourage involvement of the larger group in presentation development, scripts, graphics, etc. so everyone can participate based on individual strengths!

SWW Summit Presentation Criteria

I. Creativity

- A. Uniqueness
 - 1. Presented idea in a unique way
- B. Media
 - 1. Used appropriate props, resources, etc.
- C. Interest level
 - 1. Kept audience's attention

II. Information

- A. Organization
 - 1. Main idea was evident
 - 2. Main points flowed well throughout the presentation
 - 3. Presentation was cohesive
 - 4. Transitions were smooth
- B. Validity
 - 1. Accurate information was logically presented
 - 2. Student learning was evident
- C. Relevance
 - 1. Illustrated why this information is important
 - 2. Identified/compared trends in data
 - 3. Illustrated importance to community

III. Overall Presentation

- A. Working together
 - 1. Group was enthusiastic and engaged
 - 2. Group members presented equally
 - 3. Group members achieved smooth transitions during presentation
- B. Communication
 - 1. Spoke clearly and professionally
 - 2. Used media tools appropriately and effectively
- C. Time Limit
 - 1. Presentation was no longer than 8 minutes**
