



# Stormwater Coalition Meeting Minutes

## July 19, 2018

### TMACOG Boardroom

#### **Welcome/Call to Order:**

Jason Sisco, SWC member for the City of Bowling Green welcomed members and called the meeting to order. (Chair and vice-chair of SWC were absent due to other commitments).

#### **Introductions:**

Those in attendance introduced themselves to the group naming the jurisdiction that they represent. The SWC Attendance Roster is attached to the end of the meeting minutes noting members present, along with guests.

#### **Approval of Agenda and Minutes:**

Jason Sisco asked for a *motion to approve* today's agenda and the meeting minutes from the April 19, 2018 SWC meeting. Fred Densic, Village of Millbury *moved to approve*, and Kelly Hemminger, Township of Perrysburg, *seconded*. **Motion carried.**

#### **Ohio Stormwater Association:**

*Regina Collins, City of Toledo*

The Ohio Stormwater Association along with partners, is hosting a post construction inspection & maintenance workshop on July 26, 2018. #### **PRESENTATIONS:**

##### **The Non-Regulatory Side of Ohio EPA: Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention:**

*Jeremy Scoles, Ohio EPA Northwest District Office, Division of Environmental & Financial Assistance, OCAPP*

Scoles explained the assistance programs offered by OCAPP:

- *Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention (OCAPP)* – focuses on compliance assistance, pollution prevention and statewide recycling market development.
- *Office of Financial Assistance (OFA)* – Administers the state water and wastewater revolving loan programs and the recycling/litter prevention grant program. Includes the former DSW Compliance Assistance Unit.
- *Office of Outreach and Customer Support (OCS)* – Proactively reaches out to Ohio's communities and businesses to provide information about identifying and obtaining available service from the Agency and other sources.
- Stressed OCAPP is non-regulatory and the service is free and confidential. This is a one-stop-shop for pollution prevention and regulatory assistance for help to complete and submit permit applications and reports, develop and help maintain on-site records and on-site assessments. The E3 Awards program was explained along with the Ohio Materials Marketplace.
- Reviewed compliance with the NPDES Industrial Stormwater General Permit, SWPPs, monitoring requirement, and recordkeeping. Ohio EPA's E-Business Center was also overviewed.

### **DEFA Funding for Stormwater, Restoration Projects, Wastewater, and Drinking Water:**

*Steve Malone, Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance (DEFA), Ohio EPA*

Malone explained in detail the State Revolving Funds available. The types of funds available are:

- *Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF)*: provides funding to public wastewater systems for planning, design, and construction of wastewater systems.
- *Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA)*: provides funding to public water systems for planning, design, and construction of drinking water systems.
- How the State Revolving Funds (SRF) operate was explained. Lists of projects eligible under each loan type was given, along with examples shown. The interest rate structure was also discussed.
- Through WPCLF, principal forgiveness offered to county/local health departments can be used for repairing or replacing failing home sewage treatments. The monies distributed are income-based for qualifying home owners. The health departments administer the funds, approve project designs, inspect installation and manage the program.
- Also, through WPCLF, potential stormwater projects could be eligible. Malone reviewed a list of potentially funded projects and examples were shown.
